The e-Aadhaar password is a combination of your name letters and numbers from the date of birth. The password basically contains the first four letters of your name, followed by your year of birth. After receiving otp to download e-Aadhaar, the pdf of e-Aadhaar can be downloaded. To be able to see this, there is a need for a password. This password is called an e-Aadhaar password. How to open the pdf file e-Aadhaar? After downloading your e-Aadhaar, you will notice that the file is in PDF format. This PDF file is password protected to ensure security. Offer privacy to cardholders and avoid manipulation and misuse. What is e-Aadhaar? An e-Aadhaar is an electronic version of the physical Aadhaar that is digitally signed by UIDAI in accordance with the provisions of the Information Technology Act, 2000. The Law allows the legal recognition of electronic documents transmitted with digital signature. Main features of the e-Aadhaar card: Valid document: The e-Aadhaar card that has been downloaded is recognized as a legally valid document. In fact, the electronic version should be handled compared to the printed version. Accepted as proof of identification: This type of Aadhaar card is accepted as proof of identity for any purpose. Simply put, an e-Aadhaar card is nothing but a scanned version of the 12-digit Aadhaar card. India's Unique Identification Authority (UIDAI) offers users the facility to download e-Aadhaar on their official website. Aadhaar Card serves as proof of identity and proof of address for citizens of India. India's single Identification Authority issues and manages Aadhaar cards. The first Aadhaar card in India was issued in 2010, and since then this card containing the unique 12-digit number has been used in various sectors as a form of identification. It has personal records, home address and biometrics. Holding an Aadhaar card is not a mandatory requirement. Page 2 The wage structure of civil servants is created by the central government under the Payments Commission. Currently, the 7th Remuneration Committee is in place, which was implemented on January 30, 2018. Each decade, the Government of India reviews the wage structure of government officials, creating the Payment Commission, which recommends the wage structure for military and civilian government officials in India. According to the 7th Remuneration Commission, pensioners had a 23.63% increase in their income, while current employees had a 16% increase in their salary. However, the largest increase was 63% (approx.) for subsidies. It was done after considering the requirements of employees who come directly under the 7th Remuneration Commission. As for the latest updates under the 7th Payments Commission, the central government increased the Dearness Allowance by 3%. In addition, the Ministry of Railway also set up a committee to include some new categories within the Risk and Difficulties Grant. The retirement age of employees of the Police officer for commandment post should also be increased from 57 years to 60 years. August 5, 2020: Central Government officials are likely to receive the grace allowance for the Period January-June 2020, starting in July 2021. To generate and save funds to combat the Covid crisis, the prosecution for this period was frozen until July 2021. However, keeping in view of the increase in AICPIN, it is assumed that the compound Da for this period will be offered with monthly salaries with effect from July 2021. July 7, 2020: The Haryana Government has issued an order to freeze the Dearness and Dearness Relief Allowance for state government officials and pensioners, respectively, at current rates until July 2021 due to pandemic and economic problems. Employees, however, will continue to get from the current rates. June 25, 2020: Central government officials can now claim the travel allowance without sending a boarding pass. According to the new rules announced by the Central Government, the self-declaration together with the travel allowance application would be sufficient to prove the trip. 23 June 2020: The State government of Telangana decided to dispatch the full salary to employees without any deduction. This is happening after a two-month gap as employees were getting getting salary after deduction because of the corona crisis. Telangana announced on Tuesday that June salaries will be paid without any cut. June 11, 2020: The Uttarakhand state government has announced that there will be no increase for state government officials. The measure was taken to compensate for the losses caused by the blockade and the battle against COVID-19. a) Wage structure: The new remuneration structure recommended by the 7th Remuneration Committee includes all existing levels, and they have not introduced any new ones. b) Minimum Wage: The minimum wage of civil servants at the entry level has been increased from 7,000 to 18,000 per month, while for the new Officer Class I, the minimum wage is 56,100 per month. c) Annual Increase: According to the Seventh Remuneration Commission, the annual wage increase of 3% was maintained. d) Military Service Salary (MSP): The MSP will be paid to all defense personnel, regardless of their ranks. e) Maximum salary: The maximum salary is increased to Rs.2.25 lakhs per month for the Apex and Rs.2.5 lakhs scale for Cabinet Secretary and other categories of the same levels. f) Factor: A factor of 2.57 should be applied uniformly to the existing salary of all current employees for a new salary scale. Along with the basic salary, civil servants receive supplementary salary, which depends on the class or category of the employee. As you move higher in the rank or class of the department, the grade salary also tends to increase along with the basic salary. The calculation of various subsidies as the DA is done based on basic salary and grades. From the structure's point of view, salary-compensation helps in maintaining a fixed wage structure within various government departments. 7th Central Compensation Commission for Army and Defense The pay scale of defense personnel varies in relation to level and experience. The salary is 19,800. However, there was no change in entry - salary level of 25,530 per month. In addition, hra for assistant teachers has now been increased to 24%, 16% and 8% depending on the city. Eligibility for HRA is determined on the basis of whether the employee's attorney's office exceeded 50% and 100%. According to the 7th remuneration committee, the salary scale of associate teachers is between 1,31,400 – 1,44,200 and the grade salary is 27,000 per month. Previously, the salary scale of associate teachers was between 37,400 and 67,000 per month and the salary of the grade was 8,900 per month. Along with regular salaries, subsidies such as DA, HRA and Travel Allowance have also been increased in view of the increased cost of living. In November 2017, the central government accepted and implemented the recommendation of the Seventh Payments Commission regarding the Advancement of House Building. The interest rate on HBA is 8.5% (simple interest) for a value up to 25,000,000. Some of the important new provisions are: The amount provided by hba revised for a maximum of 34 months' salary. The maximum house cost limit that an employee can buy or build now is Rs.1 crore with a provision to increase the limit by up to 25% for deserving applicants. The provision to add a higher interest rate above the stipulated rate is withdrawn. The reimbursement of HBA will be made as – in the first 15 years, the principal amount and for the next 5 years of interest. To boost the housing sector, attractive packages are on offer, as HBA is used as a tool to encourage employees to buy a home. The announcement of the 8th wage commission is far from today. That's because the seventh wage committee was announced a short time ago. Also, if you look at the gap between each wage commission, you'll notice a minimum gap of about 10 years. Thus, by the understanding, the 8th wage committee should not be announced before 2027. However, during the term, both the state government and the center can make the necessary changes within the 7th salary range, at their discretion. The introduction of the 7th Wage Commission benefitted a large number of government employees and pensioners. Many central government employees have had their salary doubled or received at least more than 20% of the increase. The exact amount of benefits varies between each department. According to the 7th Remuneration Committee, entry level staff will receive 18,000, compared to the previous benefit of 7,000. In addition, there is an increase in the Home Rental Allowance (HRA) of 24%, 16% and 8% in several departments, along with an increase in in the Dearness Grant. According to the 7th Remuneration Committee, an annual increase of 3% is suggested for employees. The Wage Matrix two dimensions: horizontal range and vertical range. In the horizontal range, each level consists of functional role in the hierarchy, which has been numbered from 1 to 18. Whereas, in the vertical range, each level is denoting the wage increase within that level or position. According to the 7th Wage Commission, staff pay on a peak scale has been increased to 2.50 Lakh per month. Whereas, for cabinet officers, the maximum salary is 2.25 Lakh. According to the 7th Payments Commission, the defense and army salary structure has been renewed. According to the new salary matrices, the minimum amount to be paid is 56,100, while the maximum amount is 2.50 Lakh. Lakh.
